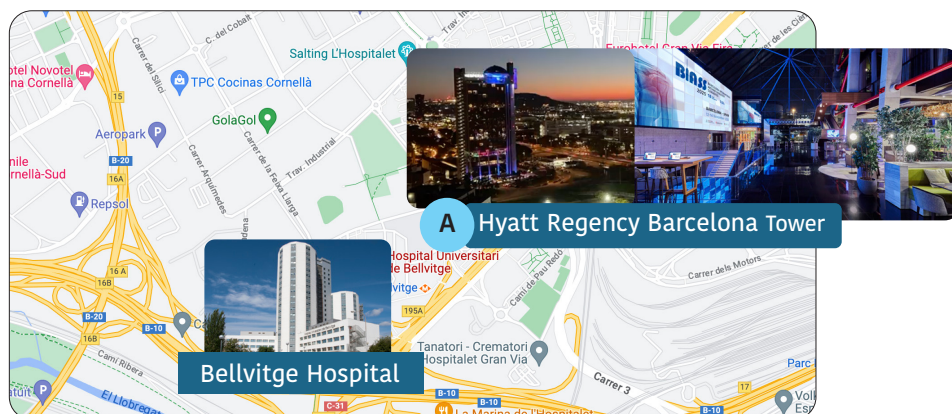

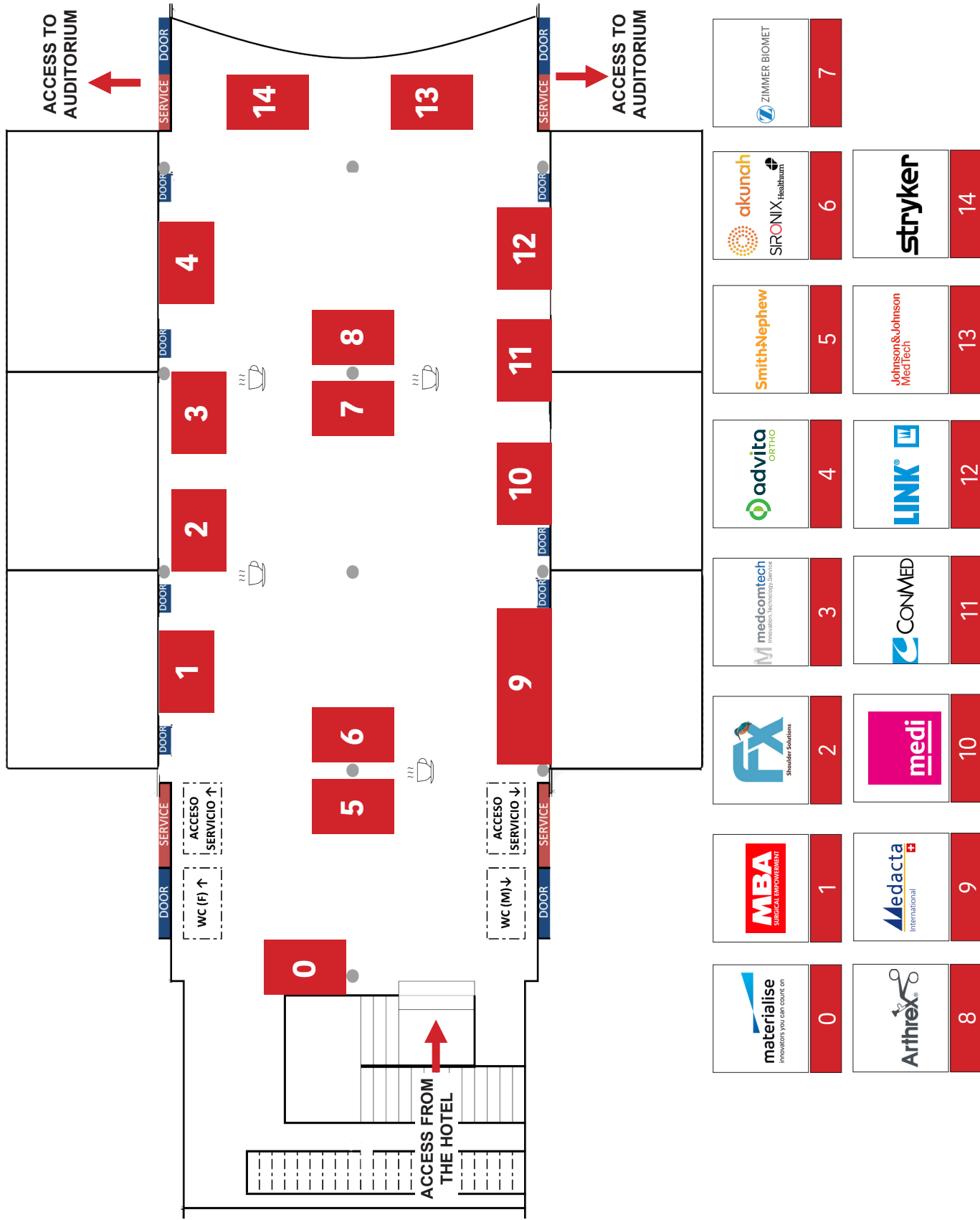

Sling vs. Dynamic Shoulder Stabilizer after Soft Tissue Shoulder Instability Surgery- "SLIDY" study

A pilot study assessing the healing and functional effects of immobilization post-soft tissue shoulder instability surgery, hypothesizing that the dynamic shoulder stabilizer promotes earlier functional recovery compared to the arm sling at three weeks of immobilization, with no differences in healing rates assessed via MRI studies.
